9. Parking Restrictions at Plaistow and Kirdford School

The following is taken from the West Sussex County Council consultation document –

Background

The provision of the proposed no waiting at any time restrictions will improve safety by preventing the obstruction of sightlines at road junctions and therefore providing safer crossing facilities for pedestrians. The removal of parked vehicles from areas with restricted forward visibility will enable through traffic to flow freely and reduce congestion at the start and end of the school day.

Discussion

The provision of the proposed no waiting at any time restrictions will improve safety by preventing the obstruction of sightlines at road junctions and therefore providing safer crossing facilities for pedestrians. The removal of parked vehicles from areas with restricted forward visibility will enable through traffic to flow freely and reduce congestion at the start and end of the school day.

The Reasons for this proposal are for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

The extent of the proposed restrictions is for the frontage of the School itself and another section on the bend at the Church. There are three maps, which are enclosed.

Members are reminded that on-street parking issues are now a civil matter and there is no mention of how the proposed restrictions will be enforced.
